



Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS)



The PALS program trains EMS and healthcare clinicians to care for pediatric patients who are experiencing life-threatening emergencies such as cardiac arrest, respiratory emergencies or shock. This program focuses on delivering high-quality care by combining psychomotor skills, airway and ventilation management, rhythm interpretation, electrical interventions and pharmacologic knowledge along with other essential skills—such as critical thinking, problem-solving, communication and teamwork - to achieve the best possible outcomes.

Neonatal Advanced Life Support (NALS)



Committed to improving newborn care, the NALS Foundations and Comprehensive courses, developed with AWHONN, provide healthcare providers with the critical knowledge and skills to manage newborn resuscitation within the hospital and out-of-hospital settings. Participants are presented with an option for an EMS-track containing cases that require them to quickly assess the newborn, analyze the data presented and determine appropriate next steps. Healthcare-focused cases, including Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, Labor & Delivery and Emergency Department, bridge the gap between theory and practice to encourage more meaningful learning that builds skills and confidence.
