Here is a snapshot of what we all accomplished together in fiscal year 2025 - which is July through June for the Red Cross – as reported through June 30. As of January, 100 Licensed Training Providers are now part of the Centennial Campaign.

We are so proud to be able to support your work and help make swim

- 23,847 individuals participated in swim lessons. When you do the average of what is counted as a swim lesson in our reporting
- system, that's about 191,000 touchpoints! • 3.320 parents and caregivers participated in water safety education and/or received CPR certification.
- 71 future lifeguards got their start through Junior Lifeguarding. • 457 lifeguards and 268 Water Safety Instructors or Basic Swim
- Instructors were trained and certified.





Making Waves in Muskegon Lakeshore! We're thrilled to spotlight the Boys &


Girls Club of the Muskegon


