



The classes offered in Lake Havasu City use the new Longfellow's WHALE Tales materials providing activity and coloring sheets, videos and so much more. Offering CPR/First Aid/AED to the tribal community has afforded training they have never had with more than 30 tribal members being certified in the first six months.

This is our first year in the campaign and we have seen the impact it has made. We have offered Lifeguarding to three tribal members who now oversee Indian Days on the lake and can't wait to see what the future
