## Use the Lifeguard Management Course to Invest in Your Upcoming Leaders

Do you have pool managers or other team members that you are looking to invest in? The American Red Cross Lifeguard Management course is designed to help lifeguard managers and aquatic professionals build on the knowledge and skills learned in the Lifeguarding course and gain aquatic industry experience. This is a great opportunity to provide additional guidance, motivation and training to set your team up for success. This includes ensuring that your facility and staff are in compliance with all guidelines, statutes and codes that apply to your aquatic facility. The course takes approximately 3.5 hours and the certification is valid for 2 years. There is an add on in-person module available to supplement the online learning course as well.

#### El Centro Aquatic Center Summer 2023 Junior Lifeguard Program

One of the goals of the El Centro Aquatic Center in the summer 2023 season was to promote Water Safety Education, specifically through the Junior Lifeguarding program.



In this 8-week program, youth from all over El Centro attended and were paired with our Junior Lifeguarding Instructor, Camila Munguia. Camila provided various forms of instruction for maximum levels of engagement from our Junior Guards. Through one-on-one and group exercises the Junior Guards got an in depth look at what it truly is like to be an American Red Cross Lifeguard.

A notable feature of this program was for Junior Guards to be able to meet and work alongside the El Centro Lifeguards. They were mentored on a daily basis by lifeguards, receiving insight and advice from those who work the front line of the Aquatic Center. Through this 8-week program the Junior Lifeguarding team was able to assist in essential lifeguarding duties, all the while learning about the cardiovascular system, AED usage, the importance of prevention and early intervention, and to work as a team to reach the desired outcome.

The Junior Lifeguards who completed this course left with a new outlook on the profession of Lifeguarding. The time spent in this program provides knowledge for an individual to take with them to the real world, creating a safer and more informed public of the future. Completion of this program grants youth with a valued experience, as well as lifelong friendships!
