

Heroes of the Heartland/Everyday Heroes Nomination Form

Event overview: Do you know a hero—someone who saved a life, made our community a safer place or gone above and beyond to help someone in need?

Each year, American Red Cross chapters in the Iowa Region present awards to local heroes. These individuals have saved lives, made significant and positive differences in their communities in the areas of emergency response, disaster preparedness and prevention or exemplified the Red Cross mission in some way. We actively seek nominations who align one or more of the Red Cross five lines of service in some way.

Red Cross Lines of Service

- Disaster Services: i.e. community preparedness educator or coordinator, disaster volunteer, search and rescue
- Health and Safety: i.e. successful CPR/AED save, choking rescue, first aid use
- Blood Services: i.e. significant blood donor, blood drive coordinator, community blood partner/promoter
- Service to the Armed Forces: i.e. therapy dogs, army base/hospital volunteers, military communications
- International Services: i.e. international humanitarian law, translation services, restoring displaced families

Note: Heroes come in many shapes and sizes. If you know someone that you think is a hero, please do not hesitate to nominate them. In the past we have honored individuals, groups, adults and children. We appreciate creative nominations!

These heroes are recognized at Red Cross Heroes events throughout the year:

- Central Iowa Heroes of the Heartland—March 2, 2017
- Everyday Heroes of Northeast Iowa—March 17, 2017
- North and Western Iowa Heroes of the Heartland—April 20, 2017
- Red Boa Ball—Salute to Heroes—April 22, 2017 (South and Eastern Iowa Chapter)

Nomination Guidelines

- The candidate must live or work in a county within the Iowa Region or the event must have occurred within one
 of these counties.
- The heroic act must be ongoing or have occurred in the 12 months preceding the Heroes event for which it is nominated.
- Hero nominee, their nominators and/or the person who was saved must be available for videotaped interviews and the Heroes event in their chapter areas.
